



ALLEGED U.S. PATENT INFRINGEMENT

Sydney, 16 November 2010

Aristocrat Leisure Limited (ASX: ALL) today confirms that it has received informal notification from International Game Technology (NYSE: IGT) alleging that the Company's US subsidiary has infringed certain IGT patents. Aristocrat has yet to be served with formal documentation detailing the claim. Aristocrat's current intention is to vigorously defend those allegations.

This claim appears to be part of an ongoing, broader intellectual property dispute between Aristocrat and IGT. In this broader dispute, Aristocrat as plaintiff, has taken action against IGT for alleged patent infringement and there is currently one case before the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California and one before the Federal Court of Australia.

At this stage, based on the current information available, Aristocrat does not consider that IGT's proposed action is material.
